Part A

The Plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and the outcome achieved by the end of the year.

The B.Ed. session 2013-14 was started on 1st August ,2013 with an orientation progrmme which began with a short prayer invoking God's Blessing on all followed by lighting of lamp by Fr. Viyanni, Anna Nagar Parish, Thanjavur and an introductory session by the faculty. The whole year's programmes were briefed during the orientation programme. Every class day began with a class assembly with a prayer invoking God's blessing on all. Keeping in mind the multi- religious nature of the society and the need for harmony and unity, Inter – Religious Prayer Services were held on special occasions like Inaugural Day, Teacher's Day, College Day, Valedictory Function etc.

1. Admission Procedure

One hundred B.Ed students and 35 M.Ed Students were admitted for the year 2013 – 2014. Relaxation was given to socially and economically weaker sections. Overall Eligibility is calculated for each candidate weighted with 60% of their qualifying examination results and 40% from the interview.

Seminars & Workshops

In order to enrich and empower our trainees several seminars and workshops were conducted during the academic year. Among them were seminars on Cooperative Learning, Specific Objectives, microteaching, planning lesson, Learning Styles, and mentoring. They were conducted by the staff members .Besides Seminars and Workshops on Teaching and Learning, National Seminar was also conducted.

A National Seminar on "Expectation and Emerging Trend's in Indian Class room" was conducted in our college on 25th January 2014. 81 Papers were selected and published in the book with ISBN. It was released on that day.

In the Inaugural Session, Inaugural address was delivered by Dr. K.Govindarajan, Professor and Head, Faculty of Education, Vinayaga Missions University, Puduchery. Key note address was delivered by Prof .Dr.K.Rajasekar, Dean Department of Education, Prist University Thanajvur. The Seminar was Felicitated by Dr.Sr. James Maria Arockiam, Vice Principal, Bon Secours College Of Education. Valedictory address was delivered by Prof.Dr.K.Chinnappan Professor and Head, Department of Education, Tamil University, Thanjavur. Delegates from different parts of the country participated in Effective discussion.

We Sent Seminar Brouchers to 500 and more Colleges and University in the National level. We have received 147 articles from the participants. Among them 81 articles were selected to publish in the Seminar proceedings. The Proceedings were published with ISBN Number (978-81-929044-05): Our management is the publisher of the proceeding.

Eminent personalities, Research guides, Professors, Research scholars and students of various colleges and universities were participated in commentable number.

This Seminar was helped a lot to everybody and it became a eye opener to know the problems of Indian class room in the present Educational Scenario. It gives solution for the same. All The presenters took active participation and their rapport is very good. Our M.Ed Students presented the papers while the B.Ed Students were the effective participants.

A Workshop on "How to design Lesson Plan" was Conducted on 12th August 2013 by M.Pazhanivel, Assistant Professor in Education, Department of Education, Tamil University, Thanjavur. Teachers and Students took active participation in the workshop.

Workshop on SUPW

The SUPW Workshop was Conducted on 21st January 2014 in Bon Secours College of Education. The Students were involved in the workshop on Socially useful productive work by Sr.Tony, Teacher St. Joseph's Higher Secondary School, Pookara Street, Thanjavur. She taught to prepare many useful things such as Washing Powder, Asafoetida, Phenyls, Omam Water, Shampoo, Candles, etc.

Seminar on Arts and Crafts

A Seminar on Arts and Crafts was conducted on 22nd February 2014. According to Instruction given by the Instructor Sr.Anthoniyammal, St. Joseph 's Higher Secondary School, Pookara Street, Thanjavur the following objects were prepared by the B.Ed Students. They are Paper Bird, Paper Flower, Flower wash, Pot Painting, Thread Work, Office Cover, File ,Glass Painting, Low Cost Materials(Egg Shell Hand Work, Wastage Paper Hand Work), etc.

Cultural Functions & Celebrations:

The cultural functions organized by the students were moderated by the resourceful faculty members. The cultural events were performed on Bon 2013, Teacher's Day, College Day, Christmas Gathering, Pongal function, Women's Day, and the Science and Literature Club activities.

Besides the cultural functions, celebrations on various occasions like Feast of Bon Secours, Independence Day and Republic Day were held. Further, too we had birthday celebrations of every member of the Bon Secours.

Tests & Competitions:

The Students also participated in Quiz Competition, Poetry Competition, Poster competition, Role Play, Debate and Patriotic Song competition on National Festival Days. Winners were given Medals/Prizes and certificates. Besides these, 'Bons Torch' (Each one Teach one)is the regular features of the college. The students also Participated in 6 psychology praticals (Intelligence Test, Attitude, Aptitude, Interest. Intelligence quotient and personality assessment) a case study and presented a project report on it.

Regarding the Examination 3 Internal Test, 2 Revision Test and 1 Model Test were conducted. Besides, They also took part in 5 cycle tests, 4 class tests, and one university examination. They were evaluated. Suitable suggestions were given. Slow learners were identified and given special treatment. Additionally, in Research Methodology the M.Ed students were trained in using SPSS Package in Analysising their data. Regarding Stastical Techniques Mr.M.Muthusamy, Senate Member, Bharathidasan University trained the M.Ed student to gain knowledge on statistical techniques on 18th December 2013.

Pre -Practice Teaching And Practice Teaching:

The trainees were introduced to learn and formulate of specific objectives, questioning techniques, introduction to Bloom's taxonomy of educational objectives, audio visual aids etc. at the beginning of the session itself. After having gone through the seminar on microteaching, the students were put through various exercises to sharpen their teaching skills. A video shoot was taken and the mistakes were corrected and the skills were Modified in Microteaching . Teachers took model lessons.

Subsequently simulation classes and criticism classes in each of the method subjects were taken by the trainees. After having gone through pre-practice teaching, the trainees were sent to our co-operating schools for practice teaching and internship from 3rd October 2013 to 2nd December, 2013. Classes were supervised by the respective school teachers and our own lecturers. The Principal expressed heart-felt thanks to the Principals and teachers of all our co-operating schools for providing ample opportunity for our trainees to better themselves as good teachers and facilitators of learning.

Annual Sports Festival:

The 11th Annual Sports Festival was held on 30th August, 2013. Importance is always given to sports and Games by Bon Secours College of Education. Annual Sports Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm on 30th August 2013.

Mr. V. Karunanidhi, District Sports Officer, Thanjavur was the Chief Guest on the occasion. He declared open the sports meet. Sports Activities like 100,200 meters, 400 meters Relay, Throw Ball, Javelin, Badminton and Shot put were conducted. The Students for the sports were selected before the annual meet. The final events were conducted on the sports day. At last our chief guest distributed the prizes and overall Championship Award for the wining Team.

Educational Tour and Picnic:

The Students of Bon Secours college of Education went one day Educational Tour on 7th March 2014. During the Tour, they visited Madurai, Vadipatti and Thiruparankundram. The bus trip, trolly ride, the hot springs and the scenic beauty of the location were thoroughly appreciated by one and all.

Research and Documentation:

- Research and Documentation is one of the goals of the college. The Faculty Members are fully committed to this. Two of the faculty members are doing their Ph.D. work and hopefully will be submitted soon. Further, papers written by the faculty members are in the process of publication in various journals. Along with these, The research activities is steadily advancing. Action Researches regarding problems and solution of school students were analyzed by the Student Teachers.
- For the Academic year 2013-2014, Thirty Five Dissertation were produced by the M.Ed Students. The Dissertations pointed the problems and solutions in the field of Educational Psychology, Current Educational problems, Environmental Education, Content part of various Disciplines, Examination Stress, Evaluation Techniques etc. They followed Survery Method, Experimental Method, Case Study Method to do the dissertation. Each M.Ed Student analyzed the Teaching

of each B.Ed student in schools and gave remedial measures for it. A Field based Activity report was prepared and submitted by each M.Ed Student.

- The Principal Dr.T. Arivalan opened the Science Exhibition in St.Joseph's Matriculation School on 18th October 2013. In his Speech, he pointed how the Students should develop Scientific Attitude. He also encouraged the Students that by gaining Scientific Attitude, they Conquer new fields in Science.
- The Principal Dr.T. Arivalan acted as a Resource Person on 11th January 2014 in John De Britto College of Education, Thanjavur on National Seminar about the "Learning Disability".

- Mr.K.A.Antony Samy Assistant Professor in Education has participated in a two day National Seminar on "Educational Research-A practical Approach" on 19th and 20th March 2014 at Madurai Kamaraj University.
- Our faculty Members Mrs.V.Uma, Mrs.S. Victoria and Mrs.J.Rajalakshmi acted as the Examiner for paper Valuation in Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University on from 26th June 2014 to 1st July 2014.

ICT Learning Resources and Spoken English:

Imparting of computer curriculum is a part of one paper in the B.Ed. curriculum. The faculty makes use of the new technologies, Power Point Presentation and LCD projectors in curriculum transactional processes. The Educational Technology Laboratory with 22 computers and internet facility is available for all the B.Ed. and M.Ed. students every day.

Considering the importance of English for communication in today's globalised world, the trainees who have difficulty in speaking and writing English were offered 40 days Spoken English Programme from 1st August 2013 to 10th September 2013.

Valedictory Function:

Classes for B.Ed. ended on 24th May 2014 with a grand Valedictory Function. The students expressed their great appreciation for the college and thanked the faculty and staff for the excellent training they received. At the end of the programme the trainees were given their final assessment report and their completion certificate. The students and the faculty together then took a pledge with lighted candles in their hands to spread the light of wisdom through the length and breadth of the country particularly in the own state of TamilNadu.

100 students Teachers appeared for the university examination conducted by the TamilNadu Teachers Education University Chennai from 30th May 2014 to 12th June 2014.The results are awaited.

Classes for M.Ed ended on 24th May 2014. 35 M.Ed candidates appeared for the University Examination conducted by the TamilNadu Teachers Education University Chennai from 30th May 2014 to 5th June 2014.

The students' entry knowledge and skills were not formally assessed but attempt was made to know the existing knowledge and skills through interaction with them in the classroom. Language Teachers, formally assessed the entry level of the students, which they used for remedial and advanced level teaching. The Psychology Teacher tested the students' intelligence, achievement motivation, Teacher effectiveness and personality through Psychological tests and the results were used for personal and academic guidance by the faculty. Together with these tests the students were continually tested and evaluated in the form of cycle tests in theory subjects.

The test scores were used for remedial teaching and academic guidance to all the three groups - the average, the below average and the above average. Thus opportunity was provided for the fullest growth of the total individuality-cognitive, affective and psychomotor.
